



After School Activities and Medications

If your child will require any medication while attending an after-school activity or overnight school trip, an NSSEO After-school/Overnight Medication Consent Form must be completed and signed by both you and your child's physician. This form is different from the NSSEO Medication Form required during school hours when a school nurse is on duty as it indicates that certified staff members may supervise the medication administration. Nurses will not be on duty at after-school and overnight activities and cannot dispense any medication except an epi-pen or inhaler to a non-nurse, including a certified school staff member. Therefore, in addition to having a separate After-school/Overnight Medication Form completed, parents must individually package their child's medications, include the child's name, medication name, dosage, and time to be given on each package (envelope), and give them directly to the certified staff supervising the activity.
