THE BEGINNING

- REACH was established in August 2009
- We saw a need for different options for adults to experience life after high school
- We began with only a handful of members, a few days per week
- As time went on, we grew in size and became a full-day program operating 5 days a week
- We currently serve 47 individuals, average of 30 per day, and have 12 staff members in our Riverwoods location
- In September of 2017, we opened a second location in Hoffman Estates that serves 9 individuals with an average of 7 members per day.
